## What is a Relaxed Performance?

Relaxed performances are designed to welcome audience members who could benefit from a more Relaxed environment including those on the autistic spectrum. This setup includes: low light in the audience during the performance, a pre-show introduction to characters/sound and light cues/what the play is about before, less intense sound and lighting effects, the ability to come and go from the space, and a quiet zone outside the theatre.

## Tickets and Venue

You can print off your tickets at home when you order them or you can pick up your tickets at the Box Office beside the entrance to the theatre. The Box Office is open from 5 p.m. to 8 p.m. There are 360 seats in the theatre. There are stairs to get up on the higher seats with railings and a balcony. Always be careful when going up to the balcony. The doors will remain open at all times.

## For this Relaxed Performance, you are allowed to:


- Attend the show **scent-free**, leaving all perfumes at home

- To bring service or trained support animals



- **You are always welcome to cover your ears or eyes when you feel uncomfortable. You may leave at any time.**




## Commute

## Busing

Buses are no longer available to take you within York. You may take a bus to any subway station and get off at York University subway stop.

## Subway

Once you come up from the York University Platform using either the escalator or elevator, you will walk up a short set of stairs before you are met with two separate ways up.



This is a picture of the elevator, located to the right when you are exiting the subway station

You can make your way up the left set of stairs and escalators , or use the elevator found on the right side . Head south, towards the Accolade East building.



This is what the Accolade East building (#92) looks like at night and day.

This is the building where the performance is happening. Enter through any door you like, there are multiple sets. Then when you see red walls and a long set of stairs you know you are in the right place. Head toward the red lobby, there will be signs.

# Parking

You can park at the James Gillies Street Garage (Student Services Garage).



This is what the garage looks at night and day if travelling south bound on James Gillies Street.

Make your way to Fine Arts Road by going north (towards more buildings) and taking the first left while walking.



This is a picture of the intersection you will have to cross at night and day. You might see this striped building at the crosswalk. That is the Accolade East building. Enter through those doors and look for the lobby. It is on the same level so do not take the stairs.

## The Lobby




This is the Lobby. To the left is the Box Office when it is closed. People will be behind the glass when it is open.





## Washrooms

There is one accessible stall on the main floor. You'll see an indentation on your right when you first walk into the Accolade East Building.



This is the closest accessible washroom on the main floor.



The yellow walls here indicate the Elevator.

The second set of washrooms are on the basement level. Go to the elevator (the yellow section of wall) and go to the ground floor.

Here are pictures of the way to the elevator and the washrooms. The two bottom pictures are of the washrooms. Each gendered washroom has an accessible stall.



## The Venue



This is what the seats inside the theatre look like.

There will be doors open on either side with ushers to guide you and take your ticket.

You may enter 30 minutes before the showtime and make yourself comfortable.

There will be a pre-show announcement and a land acknowledgement.
